It has been a very busy year on site in 2015 with demolition reaching completion and preparations well under way for the start of construction of the new One Nine Elms development.

Update on Completed Works

Demolition work is now in the final stages.

- Over the past few months McGee has been working on bringing down both buildings floor by floor using a long reach machine and works are now at the base of the building.
- A machine is being used to demolish the podium levels to the western and southern elevations.
- 2 machines have been used to sort waste materials on the ground before being removed from site. McGee look to recycle 96% of materials from demolition projects.
- Permission has been granted for investigation works to commence on the Thames Water sewer beneath the site.

Upcoming Works

- Final demolition works will be completed within the next few weeks.
- Enabling works are taking place for the main construction works to begin within the next few weeks.
